What are the barriers?

- Around 2.4 billion women of working age are not afforded equal economic opportunity
- 178 countries maintain legal barriers that prevent women's full economic participation
- 86 countries, women face some form of job restriction
- 95 countries do not guarantee equal pay for equal work.

 - Eliminated all restrictions on women's employment
